

God is Everywhere

We have learned that God is just one God, and that He is a Spirit, so we cannot see Him. But the Bible teaches us that just because we cannot see Him does not mean He isn't there. And just because He is one God doesn't mean He can't be everywhere at once. God is much greater than we sometimes think He is.

Hagar was a very sad woman. She was a slave, who had been sent away by her master. She was far away from home and thought she was all alone. But she wasn't.

Suddenly Hagar heard God talk to her! God said, "Hagar, go back to your master. Do what she tells you to do. I will take care of you." Hagar was *so* surprised! She said, "I did not think that God would see me *here!* But He *did* see me!"

God sees us wherever we are, and HE cares for us there. Even when we think that we are all alone, God sees us.
