

God is Three Persons

In an earlier lesson, we learned that there is just one God, but the Bible talks about God the Father, God the Son, and God the Spirit. This is confusing.

In the story of Moses, we learned about God the Father who came down on the mountain in a great storm. In Jesus, we see God the Son, who came to earth to save us from our sins. The Spirit lives in our hearts and helps guide and direct our lives. All three of these are the same God, and in one story, we see all of them together.

John the Baptist was baptizing people in the Jordan River. Jesus came up to him and asked to be baptized as well. When John baptized Jesus, a dove came down and sat on His head and a voice came from heaven. The voice said, 'this is my son, in Him I am pleased.'

The voice was God the Father, Jesus was God the Son, and the dove was God the Spirit. They are all the same God.
