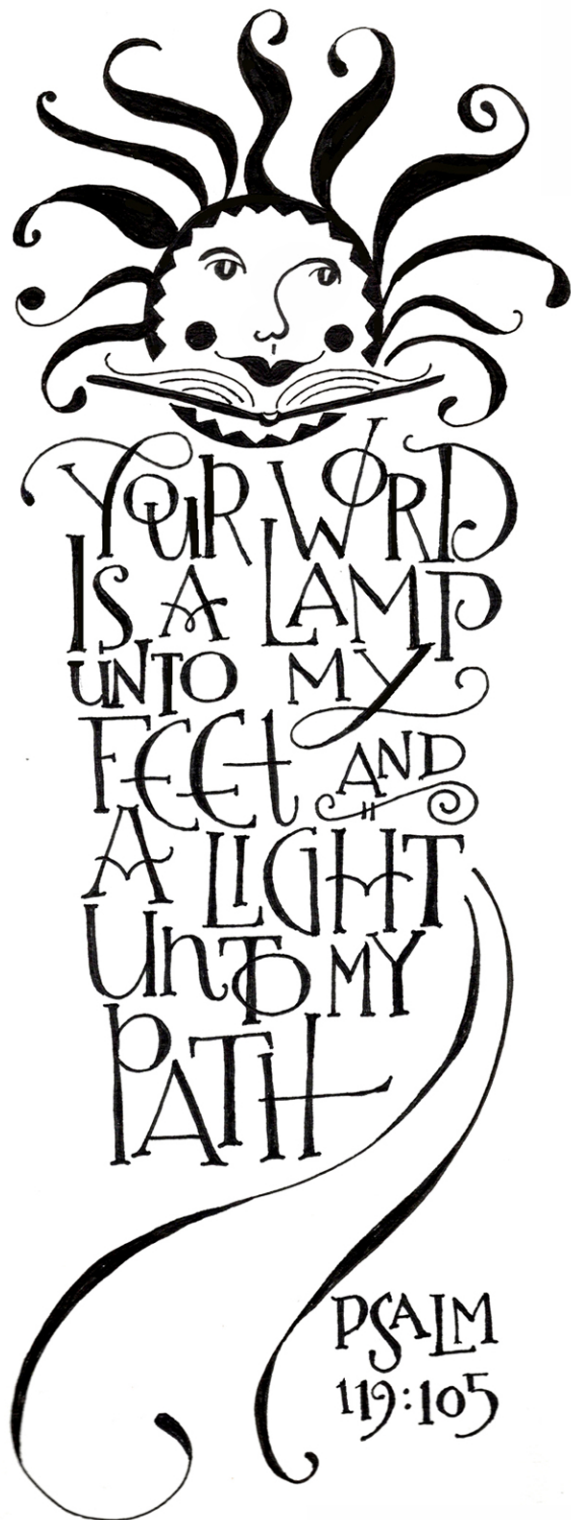

Many Bible reading plans cause discouragement as our New Year's Bible reading resolutions give way to the unexpected X-factors of life which seem to encroach with a vengeance after a few weeks or months. This plan is set up to work with all of these unforeseen distractions. Advantages to this plan include:

1. Removing the pressure to 'keep up' with getting through the entire Bible in a year.
2. Providing variety throughout the week by alternating genres.
3. Gives continuity by reading the same genre each day of the week.

In a nutshell, here's how it works:

Sundays: Poetry

Mondays: Penteteuch

Tuesdays: Old Testament history

Wednesdays: Old Testament history

Thursdays: Old Testament prophets

Fridays: New Testament history

Saturdays: New Testament epistles

This plan provides guidance as we read each day, but does not put us on an internal guilt trip if we miss a day – we just pick up with the next reading on the day it happens to be. Also, this plan allows us to see the many interconnections between sections of Scripture. So on the same day you may be reading about God's covenant with Abraham in Genesis and a few days later read Paul's commentary on the Abrahamic covenant in Romans.

Many Bible reading plans are good, but we find this one unusually helpful, for it combines two Biblical values which seem to diverge in most plans: discipline and grace.
